Over the past 3 years, the Village of Bismarck has made significant investments into their roadways with an annual seal coat rehabilitation program using accumulated MFT funds.

Scope of Work:

- Roadway Rehabilitation
 - Seal Coat, Pavement Patching, Base Improvements, etc.
- Sidewalk and ADA Improvements
- Drainage Improvements
 - Surface regrading to provide positive drainage to existing drainage facilities.

The Challenges:

1. Planning reliable, cost-effective improvements with the limited MFT funds available.
2. No long-term maintenance plans.
3. No current method for prioritizing improvements.

Solutions provided by C2:

1. C2 partnered with the Village in 2016 to help close out their previously year's projects and evaluated all existing roadways within the Village to develop a long-term maintenance plan.
2. Modified MFT program schedule to align with the Village's fiscal year to simplify budgeting and allows evaluation of roadways to take place after the winter season.
3. Work with the Village board to identify priorities and develop plans to efficiently allocate Bismarck's annual MFT budget.

C2 Engineers designs, bids, provides construction engineering and observation, and assists with all permitting and project closeout paperwork required by Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) annually.
