The Village of Potomac is responsible for and committed to the long-term maintenance of the public right-of-way and regularly dedicates the majority of their MFT funds towards roadway improvements.

 - Seal Coat, BAM leveling, Pavement Patching, Crack Sealing, etc.
- Sidewalk and ADA Improvements
- Public safety improvements
 - Tree Removal
 - Improved signage

The Challenges:

1. Planning reliable, cost-effective improvements with the limited MFT funds available.
2. Village needed assistance developing a long-term maintenance plan for continued effective spending.
3. Prioritization of necessary improvements identified based on urgency, safety, and costs.

Solutions provided by C2:

1. C2 began partnering with the Village in 2014 to assist with roadway rehabilitation planning including evaluation of existing roadways and development of maintenance plan.
2. Modified MFT program to align with the Village's fiscal year.
3. Work with Village staff to identify priorities and develop plans to efficiently allocate Potomac's annual MFT budget.

C2 Engineers designs, bids, provides construction engineering and observation, and assists with all permitting and project closeout paperwork required by Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) annually.
